Subject: **REITERATION OF THE PRACTICE ON LEARNING RESOURCE ERROR WATCH**

Date: February 17, 2022

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1. In consideration to the crucial contribution of the users' feedback to improve the learning resources, this Office hereby directs the schools to intensify the practice of giving feedback on errors found in the learning resources as directed in Division Memorandum No. 648, s. 2021 with the title "Learning Resource Error Watch."
  2. The LR error watch aims to correct content in the learning resources which **does not** conform with the standards of learning resource development such as:
    - a. compliance with learning competencies and accuracy of content;
    - b. format presentation and organization;
    - c. language;
    - d. social content;
    - e. intellectual property rights/ copyright concerns; and
    - f. freshness of information
  3. Learning resources that include the scope of the LR error watch are the Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) Learning Activity Sheets (LAS) and the video lessons of Tac TV and Tac Radyo Eskwela.
  4. School heads should monitor this concern and shall gather all findings of the teachers. Report on LR Error Watch should be submitted to [lrmds.depedtacloban@gmail.com](mailto:lrmds.depedtacloban@gmail.com) as soon as errors are found so that immediate attention may be afforded.
  5. The Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS) shall be responsible in gathering the feedback from the schools and coordinate such to the Education Program Supervisors who is in-charge of the specific learning area.
  6. Education Program Supervisors are directed to immediately take action by rectifying the error/s and by giving appropriate instructions to the schools in any feasible mode.

7. Meanwhile, errors found by the teachers should be given urgent appropriate action while awaiting for the instructions from the Schools Division Office.
8. The Public Schools District Supervisors should include this concern in monitoring the implementation of teaching/learning instruction in the schools. Reports of schools on LR Error Watch should be included in the submission of monthly report.
