MTB1-3 TEACHERS**


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1. With the steadfast aim of the department to produce literate early grade children and assist our teachers on the appropriate materials they need to meet their most essential learning competency goals in Mother Tongue (G1-3); Filipino (G2-3); and English (G3), this office informs the field of a **Three-day Training Workshop on the Utilization and Administration of Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) Tools and Scoring Worksheets on March 9-11, 2022 (Wednesday to Friday) via Google Meet** to be posted on GC a day before the activity.
 2. This training aims to:
 - a) orient the teachers on the conduct of CRLA;
 - b) equip the teachers with the knowledge on the utilization, administration, and scoring process of CRLA; and
 - c) simulate the CRLA administration
 3. Participants on this training are all MTB1-3 Teachers of Elementary and Integrated Schools which will be arranged in three batches – Batch 1 on March 9 for MTB1; Batch 2 on March 10 for MTB2; and Batch 3 on March 11 for MTB3.
 4. All participants involved on this three-day workshop are advised to be in a place where there is an excellent strong internet connection, and have joined the platform minutes prior to the opening program. Hence, this memorandum will serve as Travel Order for this purpose. Likewise, all concerned are strictly reminded to observe the local IATF health protocols while participating on this activity.
