1st VIRTUAL DIVISION-WIDE CAREER GUIDANCE DAY

1. Career Guidance is a program of the Department of Education under the Curriculum Implementation Division to help and ensure our Grade 12 learners to have an informed career decision making in the pursuit of their future career. The K-12 curriculum opens our learners to the different tracks and strands for the senior high school program and the different curriculum exits, which are, "*Trabaho, Kolehiyo, Negosyo, and Middle Skills Development.*"
2. The DepEd Tacloban City Division under the Curriculum Implementation Division, in coordination with the Youth Formation Division under the Schools Governance Operations Division and in collaboration with the Public Employment Services Office of Tacloban City, GuidanceNGO and all Junior and Senior High Schools will be conducting this first of a kind, *1st Virtual Division-Wide Career Guidance Day* for our Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners on May 4, 2022. This event, likewise, is in coordination with the DepEd Tayo Tacloban where there will be live streaming in their FB page so we can reach more learners in the Division.
3. In the morning of May 4, 2022, 9:00 am – 12:00 nn the main recipients are the Grade 10 learners, teachers and parents, inspirational talks will be given by the top management of the DepEd Tacloban City Division. The participants will also be oriented about career pathing from the Public Employment Services Office of Tacloban City. Finally, the importance of Career Guidance program will also be tackled to guide them in their pursuit of their preferred different tracks and strands in the senior high school program. All Grade 10 learners, and parents are requested to attend this event.
4. In the afternoon of May 4, 2022, 1:00 – 5:00 pm, The GuidanceNGO, a non-profit, non-government organization will conduct the Career Expedition, a FREE online Career and College Fair, designed for the senior high school learners. Learners must register thru their website with the assistance of their SHS Guidance Designates/Focal, weeks prior to the event on May 4, 2022. This event is continually being conducted throughout the academic year and participated in by thousands of SHS learners from DepEd and private schools all over the country. All Grade 12 learners are requested to join.
5. The Public Employment Services Office of Tacloban City will also be conducting their school-to-school Career Guidance and Employment Coaching (CGEC) aside from this division activity; thus, may we request all secondary schools to accommodate and coordinate with the said office in the conduct of their activities. It is advised that they may be invited during your school-based Career Guidance Day.
6. Hence, may we also request the "*Planning/Technical Working Group*" to attend the planning meeting on April 19, 2022 9am. via googlemeet. Link will be given via the SDO Junior and Senior High School FB group chat.
