**SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF VIRTUAL SYMPOSIUM ON THE COMMEMORATION OF
THE VICTORY OF MACTAN**

1. Pursuant to OULAPPP No. Q-167,s.2022 Memorandum dated April 11, 2022, this Division through the Social Mobilization and Networking Unit under the school Governance and Operations Division hereby announces to the field that the National Quincentennial Committee (NQC), together with the City Governemnnt of Lapu-Lapu will hold the Closing of the 2021 QCP-Mactan Part and the 501st Anniversary of the Victory of Mactan on April 27, 2022.
2. In support to the upcoming commemoration of the Victory of Mactan, the Department of Education, through its external Partnerships Service (EPS), in cooperation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) shall conduct a Virtual Symposium on April 26, 2022, from 2:00 p. m. to 8:00 p. m. The said event shall be hosted by DepEd regional Office VII and Schools Division Office (SDO) of Lapu-Lapu City.
3. The program shall be streamed via DepEd's Official facebook Page: DepEd Philippines which may be accessed through Facebook.com/DepartmentOfEducation.PH. To further promote the event, the Division Partnership Focal Persons (DPFPs), Araling Panlipunan (AP), and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (ESP) Education Program Supervisors (EPSs), and learners are encouraged to host a "Watch Party" of the event on their Facebook accounts.
4. Programs and activities in line with the commemoration of the Victory at Mactan shall be conducted virtually unless limited face-to-face is already allowed or if easing community quarantine restrictions commence. All activities relative to the said event should be compliant with the Covid-19 pandemic health protocols pursuant to DepEd
