**SUBJECT: DIVISION CAPABILITY BUILDING WORKSHOP ON SCHOOL-BASED

In line with DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2012 titled Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School-Based Management (SBM) Framework, Assessment, Process and Tool (APAT) which aims to strengthen the SBM Practices and engagement of school stakeholders on basic education delivery and RA 9155 also known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001 which provides the overall framework for principal empowerment by strengthening and leadership goals, and local school-based management within the context of transparency and local accountability, especially in the new normal, this Division through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) shall conduct the Division Capability Building Workshop on School-Based Management (SBM) for Level 1 & 2 Schools on June 1-3, 2022 in a venue to be announced later.
2. This Division Capability Building Workshop on School-Based Management (SBM) for Level 1 & 2 Schools aims to:
 - a. To capacitate and equip all participants on the Revised SBM Concepts, Principles and Tools
 - b. To upskill the SBM Level of practice of the Schools

 - d. To prepare each school- participant in stepping up for SBM Level 3 of Practice
3. Participants to this activity include 54 Public Secondary and Elementary School Principals of SBM Level 1 and 2 Schools, all members of the Division SBM Composite Team, 10 PSDSs and Speakers.
