1. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.

2. Interested bidders may obtain further information from **DepEd SDO-Tacloban City** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.** during Mondays to Friday.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below upon presentation of Special Power of Attorney, if not the proprietor, and payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00)** from **October 1, 2021 to October 13, 2021**.

Bidding documents (*with reference control number*) may also be sent to the Interested bidders via email after presentation of a Special Power of Attorney, if not the proprietor, and a copy of the deposit slip as proof of payment of the nonrefundable fee for the bidding documents by the BAC Secretariat (tcdobacsecretariat@gmail.com).

4. The **DepEd SDO-Tacloban City** will hold a **virtual** Pre-Bid Conference on **October 1, 2021, 9:00 A.M.** at the **Conference Hall, DepEd SDO-Tacloban City, Real St., Tacloban City**, which shall be open to all interested parties.

5. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **October 13, 2021, 9:00 A.M.** at the **Conference Hall, DepEd SDO-Tacloban City, Real St., Tacloban City**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

Virtual or online bid opening will also be available for those who could not physically attend due to border or transportation limitations and other challenges brought about by COVID-19 pandemic. Email addresses and/or contact number/s of those prospective bidders who wish to attend virtual/online bid opening should be provided to the BAC Secretariat upon purchase of bid documents.

6. The **DepEd SDO-Tacloban City** reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
