Subject: **INSTRUCTIONS RELEVANT TO CURRICULUM DELIVERY FOR THE SCHOOL OPENING 2022-2023**

Date: August 22, 2022

1. Pursuant to Dep Ed Order No. 34, s. 2022 otherwise known as the School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2022-2023, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) hereby instructs all schools in the Schools Division of Tacloban City to strictly adhere to the prescribed activities and guidelines stated hereof.

2. In this regard, the following specific instructions should be observed:

A. First Week Activities

- a. Conduct Psychosocial Support Activities as instructed in DepEd Memorandum No. DRRMS-08-20-2022-0002 for at least sixty (60) minutes each day for a week or until the learners are able to adjust in the school community.
- b. Conduct assessment or diagnosis of the reading and numeracy levels of individual learners to establish the baseline for the Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (LRCP) that will result to meaningful interventions to address learning gaps.

B. Learning Delivery & Class Programming

a. Following DO 34, s. 2022, par. V, sec. 16 (*School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2022-2023*), the schools can employ a 5-day in-person classes, blended learning (3 day-in person & 2-day distance learning / 4-day in person & 1 day distance learning) or full distance learning as the situation merits before transitioning to the full in-person classes by November or the start of Quarter 2 of this school year.

b. The delivery of learning instruction shall follow the minimum contact or teaching time of **4 hours** for Kinder to Grade 1 and **5 hours** for Grade 2 to Grade 12 as stated in DepEd Memorandum No. 30, s. 2022 (*Dissemination of the Revised School Safety Assessment Tool for the Progressive Expansion of the Face-to-Face Classes*) while observing the maximum 6-hour classroom teaching hours of the teachers in which, the remaining hours can be delivered in the distance learning instruction or in relevant teaching preparations.

However, flexibility shall be considered if situation is not feasible.

c. Class Programming shall take into account the learning modality employed by the school, showing the schedule of the learning areas that will be recited as the specific learning modality is delivered.



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
