Subject: **RECOMMENDED LEARNING RESOURCES TO CONTEXTUALIZE TEACHING INSTRUCTIONS TO THE LEARNING NEEDS & GAPS**

Date: August 19, 2022

1. As the Schools Division of Tacloban City urges the schools to initiate feasible measures to address the learning gaps, the Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS) of the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) recommends varied learning resources for reproduction, distribution and utilization for school year 2022-2023 and the ensuing school years.
2. To supplement the learning instruction, the following materials are suggested:
 - a. Big Books (as material for teaching beginning reading)
 - b. Teacher's Guide & Learner's Material in Waray Primer (Tana, Pagbasa Kita)
 - c. Waray Primer in E-Book Format
 - d. Waray Primer in Video Format (Tac TV episodes)
 - e. Teacher's Guide & Learner's Material in Bridging Primer 2 (Teaching reading in Filipino)
 - f. Bridging Primer 2 in Video Format
 - g. Storybooks/big books/small books in English (as supplement to teach reading in English)
 - h. Fuller Lessons / Worksheets/ Charts (for teaching reading in English)
 - i. Strategic Intervention Materials in Mathematics
 - j. Strategic Intervention Materials in Science
 - k. Learning Activity Sheets for Senior High School (for subjects without available LRs)
 - l. Learning Activity Sheets for EPP/TLE (without available LRs)
 - m. Recorded lessons in audio format for Junior & Senior HS (Tac Radyo Eskwela episodes)
 - n. Division Local Heritage Themes (for curriculum contextualization)
3. Consequently, the Education Program Supervisors of Mother Tongue, Filipino, English, Math., Science and EPP/TLE must coordinate with the Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS) for the preparations of these learning resources.
4. Meanwhile, the LRMS shall prepare the budget utilization plan for the reproduction and distribution of these materials and ensure that these LRs are distributed to the schools once ready for utilization.
5. Expenses relative to the reproduction and distribution of the learning resources shall be charged to BE-LCP Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
