**REITERATION OF THE SUBMISSION OF DIAGNOSTIC TESTS PREPARED
 BY THE ASSIGNED DISTRICTS PER DIVISION MEMO.
 NO. 144, S. 2022, DATED MARCH 25, S. 2022**

TO: Public School District Supervisors
 Public Secondary and Elementary School Heads
 All Others Concerned

1. Division Memorandum No. 144, s. 2022, dated March 25, 2022 emphasized the need for assessment of re-entry behaviors through a unified Division diagnostic test in the following subjects: English, Filipino, Math, and Science for Kinder to Grade 10. The number of items for each test to be prepared by the assigned district were as follows: Kinder – 20, Grades 1-3 – 30, Grades 4-6 – 40, and Grades 7-10 – 50. The diagnostic test covers the essential learning competencies of Quarters 1, 2 and 3.

2. The following are the subjects and grade levels assigned to each DLC for the preparations of the diagnostic tests.

DLC I	English, Filipino, Math	Kinder & Grade 1
DLC II	English, Filipino, Math	Grade 2
DLC III	English, Filipino, Math	Grade 3
DLC IV	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 10
DLC V	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 4
DLC VI	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 5
DLC VII	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 6
DLC VIII	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 9
DLC IX	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 8
DLC X	English, Filipino, Math and Science	Grade 7

3. The constructed tests should have been submitted to the EPS concerned on April 18, 2022. However, as of this date, there are only few tests submitted.

4. In view of this, all concerned PSDSs are requested to facilitate submission of softcopies of the prepared diagnostic tests on or before **August 26, 2022** to this email add: nmeder22@yahoo.com. The following must also be submitted together with the test items: **TOS, answers key, and results of the validation by the MTs** (content validation, construct validation, and face validation) using the instruments provided.
