2022 SOCIAL STUDIES MONTH:

77th UN Founding Celebrations and 78th the Leyte Gulf Landings -Celebrations

1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division hereby announced the official conduct of the 2022 Social Studies Month : Joint 77th United Nations Founding and 78th Commemoration of the Leyte Gulf Landings.

2. This year's celebration is anchored on the following:

Theme: "INTERGENERATIONAL SOLIDARITY: CREATING A WORLD FOR ALL AGES"
 Sub-theme: "Valuing Ground-water : Making the Invisible Visible".
 (a call to action against perennial plastic pollution, increasing the usage of environment-friendly food containers, utensils and wrappers, to turn the tide of escalating micro and nano - plastic pollution in seawaters.)

3. All schools are encouraged to observe and make the celebration more festive, colorful and vibrant, Following the suggested activities to be undertaken, below:

- a. Hanging of Streamers/tarpaulins bearing the theme of the 2022 Social Studies Month Celebration, at the most conspicuous place of the school,
- b. Holding of on-site (in-person) classroom discussions, integrating the concepts that revolves within the scope of the theme and sub-theme,
- c. Organize **School-based Activities** to amplify the awareness campaign, such as;
Advocacy symposia or forum on the roles and responsibilities of the youth in :
 - Solid Waste Disposal and Management, highlighting the crucial environmental issues and challenges ;
 - Information Drive for Youth Health ,Safety and Environmentally-driven Initiatives;
 - Drug information and Prevention.
- d. School display of UN Flags along school's front peripheral fences,
- e. Posting of the 2021 Social Studies Theme and Events' Celebration in the School's Facebook Wall, and;
- f. School-based:

Conduct of in-person UN Flag Identification contest, and Quiz Bee on UN Gen. Informations.
 Pinoy Henyo Challenge in Araling Panlipunan;
 Film-showing and Movie-review of Leyte Gulf Landings "war documentary films" and
 Story-Telling contest on heroism;
 "Great Debate" of pivotal/emerging issues that challenged the youth and the country's socio-economic & political landscape.

 Search for Balik-Kasaysayan Program's "Mini-Historical Museum and Gallery Exhibit Contest" per DLC.
- h. Division:
 History Quiz for Elementary and secondary;
 Teachers Historical Travelogue writing Contest;
 Demo-fest for Contextualized and CSE Integrated Learning Resources,
 AP Instructional Innovations Exhibit.

Educational Tour (Lakbay-Aral) of AP Teachers to visit significant historical sites involved/mentioned within the region and other places of historical interest, with approved Itinerary following strict IATF Health Safety Protocols.

School Heads are advised to arrange for a meaningful observance of the celebrations to encourage more students' participation in every academic competition, strictly adhering to the "time-on-task" and "no-disruption of classes" policy of the department, while observing the new normal IATF-Health Safety Protocols.
