1. In compliance to DepEd Memorandum OASGFO No. 2022-058 entitled "Requests for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities", this Office hereby postpones the Training Workshop on the Redevelopment of Storybooks into Animated and Interactive Format to the following dates:
 - Phase 1 - November 14-18, 2022 to July 24-28, 2023
 - Phase 2 - November 28-Dec. 2, 2022 to August 7-11, 2023
 - Phase 3 - December 12-14, 2022 to August 23-25, 2023
2. Inasmuch as the training-workshop have required outputs that need to be finished by the end of the activity, a live-in workshop will be conducted at Sabin Resort Hotel, Ormoc City where the participants are expected to stay the entire duration.
