1. Practical or applied research, in the form of an extensive piece of writing and investigation, is an integral part of our Junior and Senior High School curriculum. It necessitates skills in independent learning – students needing to make judgements and pursue their own lines of enquiry – as well as some familiarity with research methods. That is why our Research Teachers are always needed to be equipped with the right competencies in the subject and the correct strategy in the delivery of lessons for our students to acquire efficient learning and a building-knowledge tool to prepare them in dealing with their own futures, including their employment prospects. By retooling and building the pedagogical process of teaching research with the perspective of learner-centered approach, our Research Teachers can adequately impart the correct methods and strategies in delivering lessons and conducting a research study.
2. The Schools Division of Tacloban City shall conduct a 4-day **RETOOLING WORKSHOP FOR APPLIED/PRACTICAL RESEARCH TEACHERS CUM 2022 GAWAD RESEARCH AWARDS** on December 14, 15, 17 & 18, 2022 (Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday).

 - Thresh out relevant challenges as well as the issues and concerns confronting our teachers in teaching research;
 - Share teachers' practices and experiences in teaching research for the last 4 School Years, pre-pandemic period SY 2018 to 2020 & pandemic period SY 2020 to 2022; and
 - Conduct Division awards and recognition to schools who actively participated in all research activities.
