LIVE – OUT RESEARCH ADVISERS' TRAINING ON MATHEMATICS INVESTIGATION AND MODELLING

- In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 1399 s.2022 dated December 12, 2022, this
 Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division and in partnership with Curriculum and
 Learning Management Division, RO8 and Leyte Normal University Mathematics Faculty and
 Research Extension Office, will conduct the "Live-out Research Advisers' Training on
 Mathematics Investigation and Modelling" on December 28-29, 2022 at the Leyte National High
 School, AV Hall, Tacloban City.
- This activity aims to capacitate Mathematics teachers in the implementation of the Mathematical Investigation and Modelling Curriculum and to properly guide research advisers to develop learners' capabilities on producing research papers which will be an added entry to the National Science Fair under the "Likha" Category.
- Participants to this training are as follows:
 - 1 Mathematics Education Program Supervisor
 - 1 Junior High School Math Teacher
 - 1 Senior High School Math Teacher
 - 2 Senior High School Math Teachers from Private Schools Offering STEM strand
 - Teacher-Adviser participants are entitled to a service credits as per Civil Service Commission –DBM Joint Circular No.2 s.2004, provided the following are duly accomplished:
 - a. accomplishment report training attended with pictures;
 - b. daily time record duly signed by the person in an authority and
 - c. travel authority and certificate of appearance.
 - 5. To defray the cost which cover 2 meals, 4 snacks, honorarium for the resource speakers and other miscellaneous expenses in this two day activity, a registration fee of two thousand pesos (Php 2,000.00) shall be collected from the participants chargeable against School MOOE/ local funds, while private school participants may be charged to their training & development school funds.
