CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this ____ day of SEP 12 2022 2022 between **Department of Education (DepEd) - Schools Division of Tacloban City**, with office address at Real Street, 6500 Tacloban City, Leyte, represented herein by **MARIZA S. MAGAN, Schools Division Superintendent of DepEd Schools Division of Tacloban City**, hereinafter referred as to the "Entity" of the one part and the **TACLOBAN SAM'S TRADING**, with office address at **Salazar St., Brgy. 19, Tacloban City**, represented herein by **SAMUEL P. TIU** hereinafter referred to as "Supplier".

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly **PROCUREMENT OF 128,250pcs - RIMO CHOCO BLEND FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR F.Y. 2022** and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN PESOS AND 50/100 CENTAVOS ONLY [Php 1,922,467.50]** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, *viz.*:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (*e.g.*, Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;




- c. Performance Security;
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**
3. In consideration for the sum of **ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN PESOS AND 50/100 CENTAVOS ONLY [Php 1,922,467.50]** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **TACLOBAN SAM'S TRADING** agrees to supply/deliver **PROCUREMENT OF 128,250pcs - RIMO CHOCO BLEND FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR F.Y. 2022** to the DepEd Division of Tacloban City, in accordance with its Bid.
 4. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Entity to provide the goods and services and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
 5. When the Supplier fails to satisfactorily deliver goods under the contract within the specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the Supplier shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed good scheduled for delivery for everyday of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by the procuring entity concerned.
 6. The Entity need not prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Such amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due to the Supplier, or collected from any securities or warranties posted by the Supplier, whichever is convenient to the procuring entity concerned. In no case shall the total sum of liquidated damages exceed ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, in which event the procuring entity concerned may rescind the contract and imposed appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages to be paid.
 7. The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract.
 8. The **DepEd Division of Tacloban City** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.




