**2023 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS (DFOT): SINING TANGHALAN**

1. The Department of Education, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the conduct of **2023 Division Festival of Talents: *Sining Tanghalan*** on **May 18-19, 2023**.
2. The Festival of Talents aims to provide opportunity for learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools to showcase talents and skills through an exhibition of their products, services, and performances, and to provide parallel learning sessions for teachers and students to enhance knowledge and skills in their respective field of interest.
3. The participants to this activity are elementary and secondary students currently enrolled in public and private schools. Furthermore, there will be only **ONE (1) representative** for each district learning center (DLC) to every art discipline category. The **2023 DFOT-Sining Tanghalan Entry Form** shall be submitted on or before **May 2, 2023**, to the Division Office through the Education Program Supervisor in MAPEH.
4. Solidarity meeting with the teacher-coaches for the contest orientation will be conducted on **May 8, 2023**, at the SDO Office.

5. The categories, modes of delivery, number of learner-participants and teacher-coaches, and time allotment for 2023 Division Festival of Talents: Sining Tanghalan are the following:

6. In this regard, the school head shall adapt effective measures to ensure that learners still obtain full benefit of the curriculum-based instruction and directed to assign teachers or head teachers to handle the classes of identified teacher-coaches and committees.

In compliance to DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2022 entitled *Health and Safety Protocols in the Light of the COVID-19 Pandemic*, the COVID-19 risk mitigating measures shall be observed during the conduct of this activity. In addition, each arts discipline category shall implement its respective COVID-19 risk mitigating measures.
8. Travel Authority of all concerned involved in the school and district level shall be prepared by the District Office, while the members of the Division Committee shall be prepared by the Division Office.

the **CHAMPION** of the different arts discipline category will represent the SDO-Tacloban City in the *2023 Regional Festival of Talents: Sining Tanghalan* which the date and venue will be announced later.

Food, transportation, contest materials and equipment (art materials, musical instruments, dance costumes and props, medals and trophies, token, and leis) and other incidental expenses of the learners, teacher-coaches, working committee during the conduct of this activity shall be charged against Local/School/MOOE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
