**SUBJECT: INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN FUNDLIFE AND XYLEM'S YOUNG  
LEADER TRAINING ON AUGUST 22-25, 2023**

1. In reference to Partnership Communication received from Fundlife Stakeholder Engagement Officer, MS. MARIA VICTORIA O. BASILIA-YEE dated July 19, 2023 re: Invitation to Participate in Fundlife and Xylem's Young Leader Training, this Office through the Social Mobilization and Networking Unit under the School Governance and Operations Division disseminates information on the upcoming Young Leader Training Programme with Fundlife which is scheduled on August 22-25, 2023 at the Generation Amazing Community Center (GACC) located at Brgy. 106, Sto Niño, Tacloban City (beside the Old Mactan Rock Building).
2. The Programme is aimed at empowering young leaders to address water challenges in the communities through the power of football. The first three days of the training will focus on enhancing football-related skills while also teaching leaders how to adapt football games to educate communities about responsible water consumption as well as the importance of safe water, sanitation and hygiene. On the final day, young leaders will have an opportunity to showcase their learning by organizing a football festival.

  - b. Community Coaching- Developing skills and to deliver high-quality community football;
  - c. Social Impact- Creating a positive social impact through the power of football; and
  - d. Project Management- acquiring the necessary tools to organize and manage community initiatives.
