1. In order to ensure the success of the implementation of the National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP) particularly the National Learning Camp (NLC) and End-Of-The-School (EOSY) Break Activities, this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), informs the field on the Contextualized Monitoring Tool to be utilized by the Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) and Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs).

- The use of the monitoring tool will generate data on its implementation and bases for policy recommendations.
- 3. A weekly monitoring shall be conducted by the EPSs and PSDSs from July 24, 2023 to August 25, 2023 (5-week period). The Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) shall submit a weekly monitoring report of their district to the Division Office separating the NLC and EOSY monitoring tools every Friday through CID Office. (See attached Monitoring Tools)
- 4. Further, the PSDS are tasked to serve as Steering Committee Team Leader in his/her own district and shall decide on matters concerning NLC and End-Of-The-School Year Break Activities but not limited to the finalization of the List of Teacher- Learner Volunteers, Teacher's Program, Class Programs, assignment of teachers to other schools in coordination with other District Heads but in consultation with the School Heads and other related issues that may be encountered along the way that may need immediate action.
- Expenses incurred relative to this activity shall be charged against School Division/School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance of this Memorardum are desired.
