

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum no. 785 s 2023 and OUOPS Memorandum dated July 24 and July 19, 2023 respectively, this Office through the Learner Formation Division of Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) announcing the field of **The 2023 Learners TeleSafe Contact Center Helpline Jingle Making Contest**.
2. The Learners Rights Protection Office is mandated to campaign a nationwide information dissemination on the rights of the learners against child abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination and bullying and to provide learners with channel to report violation of their rights.
3. The Jingle Contest seeks to promote the contact center helpline a reporting mechanisms against violation of rights of the learners by composing a memorable jingle that acknowledges learners rights to be protected from all forms of violence, abuse, neglect, cruelty, exploitation, and maltreatment.

Specifically, at the end of the contest, the participants are expected to:

- a. To produce a jingle which promotes the Learners TeleSafe Contact Center Helpline (LTCCH);
  - b. To promote an awareness that this Department has venue where learners, teachers, non-teaching personnel and stakeholders may report incidents of all forms of abuse, bullying and exploitation; and
  - c. To encourage schools to showcase the talents of their learners in coming up with a jingle making.
4. Participation in this contest is highly encourage to promote Child Protection Policy Program. participants to this activity are open to all learners of public elementary, secondary schools and community learning centers and shall be assisted by their school music teachers in the preparation of their entry.
