**DIVISION ROLL-OUT ON HIGHER ORDER THINKING SKILLS PROFESSIONAL
LEARNING PACKAGES FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE AND ENGLISH TEACHERS
(GRADES 7-10)**

1. This Office, through the Human Resource Development Section, shall conduct a Division Roll-out Capability Building on Higher Order Thinking Skills Professional Learning Packages for Mathematics, Science and English Teachers (Grades 7-10) on November 29,30 and December 1 & 2, 2023 at a venue to be announced later.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. Deepen teacher's understanding on Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) and Structure of Observed Learning Outcomes (SOLO) framework;
- b. enhance teachers' competencies in performing SOLO-based pedagogy;
- c. improve teaching strategies and pedagogical practices that promotes the development of higher order thinking skills of the learners; and
- d. design learning activities that promote HOTS and SOLO framework.

3. The participants to this activity are Master /Head/Senior Teachers teaching English, Mathematics and Science handling Grades 6 to 10. They shall register through a link: <https://forms.gle/NqaXG5cb2PhfZtr8>.

4. Venue, name of participants and other details of this activity shall be announced in a later memorandum.

5. Meanwhile, a planning conference with the resource speakers across the three learning areas shall be held on October 20, 2023 at 4:00 in the afternoon at the Division Conference Hall.

6. The board and lodging of participants and Training Management Team and other miscellaneous expenses to be incurred shall be charged against the HRD funds, while traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds/MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
