PARTICIPATION IN THE 2024 FIRE PREVENTION MONTH CELEBRATION POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

- 1. In relation to the CY 2024 Fire Prevention Month Celebration, the Schools Division of Tacloban City through its **Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service** enjoins the identified public and private elementary and secondary learners to participate in the **Poster-Making Contest** to be conducted by the **Bureau of Fire Protection** Tacloban City on March 12, 2024, 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at Robinson's North (Activity Area), Abucay, Tacloban City.
- 2. The objective of the activity is to raise and promote fire safety awareness among learners through poster-making.
- 3. There are two (2) categories, elementary and secondary level for both public and private schools. The theme of the said contest will be consistent with the 2024 Fire Prevention Month Celebration theme: "SA PAG-IWAS SA SUNOG, HINDI KA NAG-IISA".

The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Creativity and Presentation - 15%
b. Originality - 15%
c. Relevance of the Theme - 30%
d. Artistic Composition - 20%
e. FB Likes/Heart - 20%

- 4. BFP will provide the materials such as ¼ size illustration board, pencil, sharpener, eraser, and pastel color (16 colors) in the conduct of activity. However, participants can bring and use their own preferred coloring materials.
- Each learner-contestant much be accompanied by his/her coach.

- 7. However, participation of schools shall be subjected to the **no-disruption-of-classes policy** as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s.2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

Moreover, this Office would like to reiterate that all participating learners should secure parent's consent prior to their attendance to the activity and the School Head should ensure that the necessary arrangements would be made to have available teachers to take charge of the classes handled by the participating teachers.
- Expenses incurred relative to the attendance during the activity shall be charged to Local Funds/School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
