FUNDLIFE DREAMS IN COLOUR CONDUCTS TWO-DAY WATER FESTIVAL

1. In reference to Partner-Stakeholder Communication received dated March 13, 2024, this Office through the Social Mobilization and Networking Unit under School Governance and Operations Division announces that Fundlife International will conduct its two-day Water Festival in celebration of the World Water Day. This will be held at the Generation Amazing Community Club, Brgy. 106 Sto. Niño, Tacloban City on March 16-17, 2024.
2. All School Heads of FFLA Partner Schools have to ensure that Consent Forms were previously sent to the concerned parents and guardians of those identified students to participate in this event.
3. This two-day water festival is aimed to:
 - a. Increase youth engagement in water pollution awareness activities and promote water sanitation and conservation practices;
 - b. Strengthen Fundlife, and communities relationship by providing actionable solutions to water issues; and
 - c. Promote objective-driven activities to encourage youth participation in addressing the water crisis.
4. This two-day Water Festival targets to involve a total of 400 children. Through the event, a total of 104 matches will be played under 5 game categories (U13 Boys and Girls, U15 Boys, U17 Girls and U20 Boys). The event will also include 15-20 youth and community leaders from partner community of Fundlife where the newly established multisports and learning facility is constructed. This activity will also help raise community awareness on water related issues and concerns that youth

can help address. It also targets to hold a short educational discussion on Water, Water Sanitation and Health.

5. Transportation services, Snacks and viand for lunch shall be provided by Fundlife. However, student-participants shall have to provide their own Rice.
6. Teachers who will be involved and participate in this two-day activity shall prepare the necessary documents to avail of their Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC).
7. Activities to be participated in by Student-Participants during the two-day event are as follows:
