**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP (NLC) YEAR 2**

1. This has reference to the Deped Order No. 13, s. re **“Adoption of National Learning Camp Recover Program and DepEd Order No. 14, s., 2023 on “Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of Nayional Learning Camp” National Learning Camp** to be conducted last March 15, 2024.
2. As such, the following activities shall be conducted in school:
  - a. **Advocacy Activities**
    1. Strengthen advocacy activities through social media platforms and tarpaulin in all governance level.
    2. Reaching the struggling/ in high needs learners.
  - b. **Registration**

The registration for the current Grades 7 & 8 student-volunteers for the NLC and EOSY activities other grade levels shall be on **March 20-31, 2024**.
  - c. **Potential Number of Learning Camp Volunteers**

In determining the potential number of learning camp volunteers (LCV), teachers shall submit to the School Head the consolidated number learner’s per camp (enhancement, consolidation and intervention camps) , per learning area.
  - d. **Camp Size**

The following shall be strictly observed:

    1. Intervention Camp – maximum of 10 volunteer- learners;
    2. Consolidation Camp – maximum of 35 volunteer-learners; and
    3. Enhancement Camp – maximum of 35 volunteer-learners.
  - e. **NLC Duration**

Week 1- (July 1-5, 2024)  
Week 2- (July 8-12, 2024)  
Week 3- (July 15-19, 2024)  
Week 4- Assessment Data, Organization and Analysis, Post Survey



**f. Time Duration**

Enhancement Camp- 4.5 hours/day  
Consolidation Camp- 4.5 hours/day  
Intervention Camp- 4.5 hours/day

**g. Collaborative Expertise**

**Monday**- is a Collaborative Planning and Review  
**Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday**- 3-day teacher-learner engagement  
**Friday**- Collaborative Review Instruction

**h. Process Flow of Data**

The School Heads shall consolidate the number of volunteer- teachers and learner - volunteers per camp, per learning area, and grade levels as well as those who would most likely fail in 1 or 2 learning areas outside NLC and submits the said data to their respective Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs).  
The PSDS, shall submit their consolidated data to the SDO-CID on or before **April 15, 2024** for consolidation in preparation for the regional consolidation.

**i. Requirements**

Learner-volunteers shall provide Parents' Permit while Teacher-volunteers shall accomplish the Expression of Intent Template and the Registry of Learning Camp Volunteers.(See Attachment).

**i. Bases for Camp Placement**

1. Pre-Assessment Results, Rapid Math Assessment (RMA) Post Assessment Results (CRLA) for Grades 1 to 3, NLCA Grades 7 to 10/ Simple Screening Test in Reading and Math, BEA Results or Report Cards

**j. Allowable Expenditures**

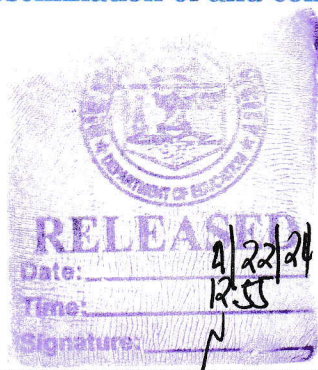
1. Printing/Reproduction of Teaching and Learning Resources including Answer Sheets (AS) for the learners will be dependent on the number of volunteer-learners.
2. Payment of Meal Expenses (P250.00/day) for DepEd Learning Camp Volunteers and/or Remuneration of Non-DepEd Learning Camp Volunteers.
3. Expenses related to the conduct of Orientation activities in the Implementation of the 2024 NLC.

**k. Engagement of Learning Camp Volunteers**

**April 10-26**- Call or Learning Camp Volunteers (LCVs)  
**LCV**- Refers to a DepEd or non-DepEd lecene teacher who renders tailored institutional services to a target group of learners within a specific period.  
**NON-DepEd LCVs**-Remaining LET applicants in RQAs who are not given appointments; other LET eligible in the locality private schools, SUSs.LUCs, other teaching practitioners, other LET eligible teacher applicants in the above mentioned RQAs who did not meet the cut-off score per existing DepEd hiring guidelines.

**l. Incentives**

1. Meal allowance (**P250.00**) for teacher-volunteers per day, **Service Credits** and **National Certificates**.
3. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
