2024 DIVISION SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, AND MATHEMATICS FAIR

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 1094 s.2024 titled 2024 Division, Technology, and Mathematics Fair (RSTMF), this division through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the Division Science, Technology, and Mathematics Fair (DSTMF) on **September 25-27, 2024 at Tacloban City Night High School, Tacloban City.**
2. The activity aims to:
 - 2.1 promote Science, Technology, and Mathematics consciousness and culture of innovation among the youth;
 - 2.2 give learners the opportunity to showcase their knowledge acquired in Science and Mathematics content;
 - 2.3 develop learners' essential research skills for academic success and future academic and career pursuits; and
 - 2.4 identify the most creative and innovative student researches from the Junior and Senior High Schools who shall represent the division in the regional Science-Mathematics fair.
3. The following are the contested activities:

Contested Activity	Grade Level	Individual	Team
Math Quiz	Grades 1-11 (max of 3 contestants per grade level and 3 contestants for each special program)	(3) contestant	Top 2- scorer in the individual category
Mathematics Computational Science	Grade 9-12 (max of 3 contestants per grade level)	(1) contestant	(3) contestants

4. All schools both private and public shall send representatives for individual and team categories for each grade level for Math quiz while schools offering special programs shall send representatives for each program.
5. A registration fee of one hundred pesos (Php100) shall be collected from each participant chargeable against School MOOE / GPTA / SELG / SSLG / Canteen / other locally generated funds subject to usual accounting rules and regulations to defray the expenses of the medals, trophies, certificates, meals and tokens for the board of judges, decorations, and other miscellaneous expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity.
