**CORRIGENDUM TO DM 936 S. 2024 TITLED DIVISION
SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC) 2025**

1. Due to procurement concerns, this Office thru the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) informs the field of the changes, and clarifications, to wit:
 - a. Resetting of the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) 2025, from **January 9-11, 2024** to **January 16-18, 2024 at Leyte National High School, Tacloban City.**
 - b. Paragraph 4a. of the Memorandum on Group Contests guidelines specifically, statements iii and iv stipulates respectively:
 - iii. Online Publishing (English and Filipino, **Junior High Schools Only**)
 - iv. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting (English and Filipino, **Junior High Schools Only**)
- per attached specific Guidelines of DepEd Memo No. 025 s. 2024 of the 2024 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), for Online Publishing it is acknowledged that “Each region shall organize a team of five (5) members for English and Filipino in **secondary level...**” while for TV Script Writing and Broadcasting, “Each region must form a team of seven (7) members for English and seven (7) members for Filipino in elementary level and **secondary level ...**” Hence, this memorandum rectifies **Secondary**

Level to include Junior and Senior High School in both of the Group Contests cited above.

- c. Paragraph 12 of DM936 cites of a registration of **One Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php150.00) per campus journalist; and Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php250.00) for each School Paper Advisers** which will be collected to all participants to defray expenses for the purchase of medals, trophies, office supplies, payment of honoraria of judges, and meals for the TWG, judges, and tabulators chargeable against School MOOE/Local Fund/Campus Journalism Fund, and other available sources subject to the current accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
2. Attached hereto are the members of the Technical Working Group and the Activity Matrix for reference.
3. All other provisions stipulated in DM936 s. 2024 are still in effect and enforce.
4. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum are desired.
