**REITERATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL INITIATIVE
INTERVENTION (SII)**

1. **The Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM)** is a non-traditional educational program recognized by DepEd that applies a flexible learning philosophy and curricular delivery program that includes non-formal and informal sources of knowledge and skills. Instructional learning modalities do not strictly follow the typical setup for regular classroom instruction but follow the K to 12 curriculum in content.
2. Sub Immediate Outcome 2.1 states that all school-age children youth and adults in situations of disadvantage should be participating in inclusive basic learning opportunities and receiving appropriate quality education.
3. One of the ADM programs is the **School Initiated Intervention (SII)** which is one of the strategic components of the **Drop-out Reduction Program (DORP)**. It is an intervention developed by the school itself to address specific drop-out problems, i.e. *poor medical conditions, working at day time, being involved in curricular and co-curricular activities, natural calamities, man-made disasters, etc.*
4. To address learning gaps due to the above-mentioned factors, this office hereby directs all schools to prepare School Initiated Interventions following the suggested elements to be submitted on or before **July 18, 2025**, to wit;



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
