**DISSEMINATION OF IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11168, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ACT ALLOWING HOME ECONOMICS GRADUATES TO TEACH HOME ECONOMICS SUBJECTS AND HOME ECONOMICS-RELATED TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL SUBJECTS IN ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, RESPECTIVELY, CONSISTENT WITH SECTION 8 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10533 OR THE ENHANCED BASIC EDUCATION ACT OF 2013"**

1. For the information, guidance and reference of all concerned, enclosed is a copy of the ***Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act No. 11168, Otherwise Known as "An Act Allowing Home Economics Graduates to Teach Home Economics Subjects and Home Economics-Related Technical-Vocational Subjects in All Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Educational Institutions, Respectively, Consistent with Section 8 of Republic Act No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013"***.
2. The IRR provides for the qualifications, scope, and guidelines for the employment of Home Economics graduates as teachers of Home Economics and related technical-vocational subjects in both elementary and secondary levels. It supports the Department's goal to strengthen the implementation of the K to 12 curriculum by ensuring adequate and qualified personnel in delivering technical-vocational-livelihood (TVL) tracks, especially in the area of Home Economics.
3. Public Schools District Supervisors through the school heads are advised to:
  - a. Disseminate the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA No. 11168 to all concerned teaching and non-teaching personnel within their respective schools and districts;
  - b. Encourage qualified Home Economics graduates to complete the necessary teacher certification and/or TESDA National Certificate to ensure compliance with the standards set by DepEd and;
