**STRENGTHENING AGAPE THROUGH VALUES IN SCHOOL PROGRAM
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026**

1. Altering Gap and Personal Experiences (AGAPE) is a division-wide Values Formation initiative that aims to promote holistic development among learners by engaging external stakeholders in the conduct of God-centered values sessions. These sessions are held once a week for 30 minutes across all key stages.
2. The field is hereby informed that the deployment of LIFE COACHES will commence in the third week of July 2025. Accordingly, all LIFE COACHES are directed to conduct a courtesy call to their respective school heads for proper scheduling and grade level assignment
3. The AGAPE Program shall conduct the following activities, subject to the availability of schedule:
 - a. a deployment meeting of cluster leaders will be conducted on July 16, 2025, at San Fernando Central School. All school leaders from the previous school year are requested to bring a hard copy of their AGAPE implementation report.
 - b. A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signing with CCM, PNP, CEF, PEV, and other values-oriented organizations will be conducted in August 2025. This activity will be organized by the PNP Life Coaches, with the venue and other details to be announced at a later date.
 - c. Regular quarterly meetings with Life Coach leaders per school shall be scheduled as the need arises.
4. It is hereby reiterated that Life Coaches assigned to schools must strictly observe the agreed boundaries, as outlined below:
 - a. *No form of religious or congregational recruitment shall be practiced; sessions must focus solely on God-centered values education.*
