- 2. A resident of the Philippines for at least one (1) year and in the place wherein he/she proposes to vote, for at least six (6) months immediately preceding the BSKE;
- 3. No otherwise disqualified by law.

B. Sangguniang Kabataan Elections:

- 1. At least fifteen (15) but not more than thirty (30) years of age and residing in the barangay for at least six (6) months on or before Sangguniang Kabataan Elections; and
- 2. Not otherwise disqualified by law.
- 4. For qualified voters who are first-time registrants, they have to bring at least one (1) government issued ID with photocopy (e.g. School ID, Library Card, etc.) and birth certificate whether PSA or LCR issued with photocopy.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Division Memorandum and compliance thereto are highly desired.
