- iii) Provide opportunities among researchers/innovators to present their plans and projects in at least the division level.
- iv) Provide technical inputs and suggestions for enhancement and improvement of the study.
- 4) Participants for the said activity are the following:
 - i) Proponents of submitted proposal (Solo/Group)
 - ii) Members of the Panel of Evaluators
 - iii) Secretariat of the Planning & Research Section.
- 5) Specific Guidelines during the project proposal hearing:
 - Each research/innovation proposal shall be presented by the lead proponent supported by other members of the group.
 - Presenters are advised to prepare a presentation (power point) that shall last for 10 minutes per research project. The slide deck should be composed of the following:
