**UPDATES TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 881, s. 2025 Titled:
PREPARATION AND UPDATES OF THE CONDUCT OF DIVISION SCHOOLS
PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC) AND SCHEDULE AND VENUE OF CONTESTS**

ALL CONCERNED**

1. This is to inform all concerned that the conduct of the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC), originally scheduled on November 6–8, 2025, is hereby rescheduled to November 7–9, 2025.
2. The Orientation for all Contest Facilitators and Contest Managers originally scheduled on November 3, 2025, is hereby rescheduled to November 6, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. The venue remains at the AV Hall, Leyte National High School.
3. Furthermore, the Preparatory Activity with the Technical Working Group (TWG) initially set on November 4–5, 2025, is also rescheduled to November 5–6, 2025 at Leyte National High School. This activity will focus on the preparation of certificates, programs, medals and trophies, and the contest venue.
4. This adjustment is made in consideration of the weather disturbance brought by the current typhoon affecting the region, and to ensure the safety and readiness of all participants. Likewise, the rescheduling aims to provide ample time for learners and their coaches to make necessary preparations.
5. Since the second and third day of the activity falls on a Saturday and Sunday, two (2) day of Service Credits (SC) shall be granted to all participating teacher-coaches who complete the entire duration of the event. The granting of service credits shall be in accordance with DO 013, s. 2024 – Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Service Credits for Teachers.
6. All other related activities, venue assignments, and guidelines shall remain in effect unless otherwise announced.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with these guidelines are hereby expected.
